#### USE

**Location**: park, central reservation, large garden, countryside, ecological zone | **Pavement**: none, open, sealed | **Planting concepts**: Climate planting, food forest, Eco planting, Landscape planting, Prairie planting

#### CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide egg-shaped | Crown structure: dense | Height: 5 - 8 m | Width: 4 - 6 m | Winter hardiness zone: 5A - 7B

## **ASPECTS**

Wind: tolerant to wind | Soil: loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | Nutrient level: moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | Soil moisture level: moist, wet | Light requirements: sun, partial shade | pH range: acidic, neutral, alkaline | Host plant/forage plant: bees, nectar value 5, pollen value 5 | Extreme environments: tolerant to dryness, tolerates heat

### **PLANTKENMERKEN**

Flowers: raceme, small, scented | Flower colour: white-pink | Flowering period: April | Leaf colour: green | Leaves: deciduous, ovate, ovoid, dentate | Autumn colour: red-brown | Fruits: small, plum | Fruit colour: yellow, red | Bark colour: dark brown | Bark: smooth, later on rough | Twig colour: green | Twigs: slightly thorned
