**Location:** street, park, central reservation, large garden | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** food forest, Eco planting, Prairie planting

## CHARACTERISTICS

**Crown shape:** ovoid, egg-shaped, narrow egg-shaped | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 5 - 8 m | **Width:** 6 - 10 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 8B

## ASPECTS

**Wind:** intolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, nectar value 5, pollen value 5 | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness

**Flowers:** singular, small, scented | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** April - April | **Leaf colour:** dark red, buds red | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovoid, polished, serrate | **Autumn colour:** red-brown, red-violet | **Fruits:** discrete, edible, plum | **Fruit colour:** dark red | **Bark colour:** dark brown | **Bark:** smooth, later on rough | **Twig colour:** dark red, green | **Twigs:** bare
