TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, half-stem trees | **Topiary on stem:** globe

USE

Location: street, square, park, central reservation, large garden, small garden | **Pavement:** none, open

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 3 - 5 m | **Width:** 1 - 3 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 6B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: discrete | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** April - April | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, ovoid, serrate | **Autumn colour:** yellow-orange, red | **Fruits:** rarely fruits | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** slightly furrowed | **Twig colour:** grey | **Twigs:** bare
