Tree types: standard trees

USE

Location: avenue, square, park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, ecological zone | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Eco planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: narrow vase-shaped | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 5 - 6 m | **Width:** 5 - 6 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline (5.5 - 8.0) | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: raceme, striking, pendulous, singular, big | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** April - April | **Leaf colour:** buds bronze, blue-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, obovate, ovoid, serrate | **Autumn colour:** yellow-orange, orange-red | **Fruits:** rarely fruits, small, cherry, drupe | **Fruit colour:** orange-red | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** smooth, later on rough | **Twig colour:** grey-brown | **Twigs:** bare, with lenticels | **Root system:** shallow, compact
