USE

Location: park, central reservation, in containers, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown structure: dense | **Height:** 1 - 2 m | **Width:** 0 - 1 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 7A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, nectar value 3, pollen value 3

Flowers: corymbose, standing | **Flower colour:** cream-white | **Flowering period:** May - May | **Leaf colour:** buds bronze, dark green | **Leaves:** evergreen, ovoid, leathery, polished | **Fruits:** striking, toxic, small, berry | **Fruit colour:** dark violet | **Bark colour:** brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** green | **Twigs:** bare
