Location: street, square, park, central reservation, large garden, small garden, cemetery, coastal area | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Eco planting, shade-tolerant

Crown shape: vase-shaped | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 0.9 - 1 m | **Width:** 1.2 - 1.5 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6B - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, birds, nectar value 3, pollen value 3 | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution

Flowers: raceme, standing, flower-scented | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** May - June | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** evergreen, ovoid, lanceolate, narrow, leathery, polished, scented with contusion | **Fruits:** toxic, small, cherry | **Fruit colour:** black | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** green | **Twigs:** bare | **Root system:** shallow
