Location: park, central reservation, in containers, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, coastal area | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** shade-tolerant

Height: 0.6 - 0.8 m | **Width:** 1 - 1 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 7A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline (6.0 - 8.0) | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, birds, nectar value 3, pollen value 3 | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution

Flowers: corymbose, star-shaped, weakly scented | **Flower colour:** white, cream-white | **Flowering period:** May - June | **Leaf colour:** dark green | **Leaves:** ovoid, thick, leathery, polished, serrate | **Fruits:** toxic, berry | **Fruit colour:** blue, black | **Bark colour:** cream | **Bark:** slightly furrowed | **Twig colour:** pale green | **Twigs:** bare, polished | **Root system:** shallow, coarse roots
