TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: solitary shrubs | **Other types of planting:** undergrowth

USE

Location: street, park, large garden, small garden, coastal area | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** shade-tolerant

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: vase-shaped | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 2 - 4 m | **Width:** 2 - 4 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline (6.0 - 8.0) | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, birds, nectar value 3, pollen value 3 | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution

Flowers: raceme, standing, scented | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** May - June | **Leaf colour:** dark green | **Leaves:** evergreen, ovoid, leathery, polished | **Fruits:** toxic, small, cherry | **Fruit colour:** black | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** green | **Twigs:** bare | **Root system:** shallow
