Tree types: standard trees, solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella | **Topiary:** hedge element, pleached

Location: street, avenue, square, park, central reservation, in containers, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery | **Pavement:** open | **Planting concepts:** shade-tolerant

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide egg-shaped | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 3 - 4 m | **Width:** 3 - 4 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 7A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, nectar value 3, pollen value 3

Flowers: raceme, standing, flower-scented | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** evergreen, obovate, big, thick, leathery, polished, scented with confusion | **Fruits:** toxic, small, cherry | **Fruit colour:** black | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** green | **Twigs:** bare
