TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, multi-stemmed trees, shade trees, solitary shrubs

USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, countryside, ecological zone | **Pavement:** none, open | **Planting concepts:** Eco planting, Landscape planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: egg-shaped | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 8 - 15 m | **Width:** 6 - 8 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 3A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to salt spray, tolerates air pollution

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: raceme, standing, small, flower-scented | **Flower colour:** cream-white | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, lanceolate, dentate | **Autumn colour:** yellow | **Fruits:** rarely fruits, small, drupe | **Fruit colour:** dark red, black | **Bark colour:** yellow-orange, red-brown | **Bark:** peeling, smooth, striped | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** hairy | **Root system:** shallow, extensive, slightly branched
