**Tree types:** standard trees, feathered trees

### USE

**Location:** park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery, countryside, ecological zone | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Eco planting, Landscape planting

### CHARACTERISTICS

**Crown shape:** wide pyramidal | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 8 - 10 m | **Width:** 7 - 9 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 3A - 8B

### ASPECTS

**Wind:** slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil, all soils | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist, wet | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline (6.0 - 8.0) | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, birds, nectar value 3, pollen value 3 | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to short-term flooding

**Flowers:** raceme, pendulous, singular, weakly scented | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovoid, serrate | **Autumn colour:** yellow-orange, red | **Fruits:** small, drupe | **Fruit colour:** black | **Bark colour:** pale brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** grey-brown | **Twigs:** bare | **Root system:** deep, shallow, root suckers
