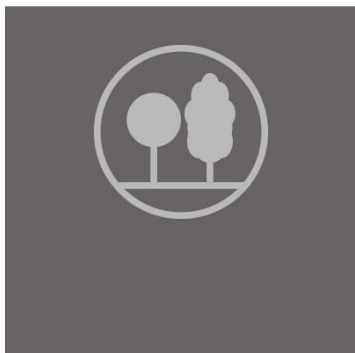


Prunus pensylvanica 'Auburn Splendor'



TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees

USE

Location: avenue, park, central reservation, large garden | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: flattened spherical | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 6 - 8 m | **Width:** 4 - 8 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 3A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: raceme, striking, small | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, lanceolate, narrow | **Autumn colour:** yellow, red | **Fruits:** small, drupe | **Fruit colour:** red | **Bark colour:** brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** brown | **Twigs:** bare
