**Wind:** intolerant to wind | **Soil:** light clay, sand, all soils | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, birds, small mammals, humans, nectar value 5, pollen value 5

**Flowers:** striking, singular, flower-scented | **Flower colour:** pink | **Flowering period:** April - April | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, lanceolate, serrate | **Autumn colour:** yellow | **Fruits:** striking, edible, plum | **Fruit colour:** yellow-orange | **Bark colour:** dark brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** red, green | **Twigs:** bare
