TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, multi-stemmed trees, solitary shrubs

USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Eco planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 8 - 12 m | **Width:** 6 - 7 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 3A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist, wet | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline (4.5 - 8.0) | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, birds, small mammals, nectar value 3, pollen value 3 | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to short-term flooding

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: raceme, star-shaped, standing | **Flower colour:** pink | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** buds bronze, dark green, underside dark red | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, ovoid, polished, serrate | **Autumn colour:** yellow, red-brown | **Fruits:** edible, small, cherry | **Fruit colour:** blue-black | **Bark colour:** brown, black | **Bark:** peeling | **Twig colour:** dark brown | **Twigs:** bare | **Root system:** extensive, highly branched, root suckers
