Tree types: standard trees, half-stem trees | **Topiary on stem:** globe

USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden, small garden, cemetery | **Pavement:** none, open | **Planting concepts:** Eco planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 3 - 4 m | **Width:** 2 - 3 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 3A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Soil moisture level:** dry, wet | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, nectar value 3, pollen value 3

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: raceme, pendulous, strongly scented | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, ovoid, small, serrate | **Autumn colour:** yellow, yellow-orange | **Fruits:** rarely fruits, edible, small, cherry | **Fruit colour:** black | **Bark colour:** brown, black | **Bark:** peeling | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** bare
