USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Eco planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: pyramidal | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 9 - 12 m | **Width:** 6 - 8 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 3A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist, wet | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral (5.0 - 7.0) | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, birds, nectar value 3, pollen value 3 | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution

Flowers: raceme, strongly scented | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** matt green, underside blue-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, serrate | **Autumn colour:** yellow-orange | **Fruits:** few fruits, berry | **Fruit colour:** black | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** bare | **Root system:** extensive, highly branched, central root, root suckers
