USE

Location: park, central reservation, roof garden, large garden, cemetery, countryside, ecological zone | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Eco planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 8 - 12 m | **Width:** 6 - 10 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 3A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist, wet | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, nectar value 3, pollen value 3 | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to short-term flooding

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: raceme, pendulous, big, scented | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, obovate, ovoid, doubly serrate, composite | **Autumn colour:** yellow, yellow-orange | **Fruits:** rarely fruits, edible, small, drupe | **Fruit colour:** black | **Bark colour:** brown, black | **Bark:** peeling | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** bare | **Root system:** root suckers
