Tree types: standard trees, multi-stemmed trees | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: street, avenue, park, central reservation, in containers, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery | **Pavement:** none, open

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide vase-shaped | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 3 - 5 m | **Width:** 3 - 5 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5B - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, nectar value 3, pollen value 3

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: raceme, half filled | **Flower colour:** pale pink | **Flowering period:** January - April | **Leaf colour:** buds bronze, green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, doubly serrate | **Autumn colour:** yellow, orange-red | **Fruits:** discrete, rarely fruits, small, drupe | **Fruit colour:** black | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** brown | **Twigs:** hairy
