TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, multi-stemmed trees, characteristic trees, solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 6 - 8 m | **Width:** 6 - 8 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline (5.5 - 8.2) | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees

Flowers: raceme, singular | **Flower colour:** cream-white | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** bright green, underside pale green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovoid, serrate | **Autumn colour:** yellow-orange | **Fruits:** small, cherry | **Fruit colour:** red | **Bark colour:** orange-red, red-brown | **Bark:** peeling, striped | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** bare, with lenticels | **Root system:** deep, tap root
