Tree types: standard trees

USE

Location: street, avenue, square, park, central reservation, large garden | **Pavement:** none, open

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: narrow vase-shaped | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 6 - 8 m | **Width:** 3 - 4 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** neutral, alkaline

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: raceme, half filled, flower-scented | **Flower colour:** pale pink | **Flowering period:** April - April | **Leaf colour:** buds bronze, dark green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, serrate | **Autumn colour:** orange-red, red-violet | **Fruits:** no fruit | **Bark colour:** brown | **Bark:** slightly furrowed | **Twig colour:** dark brown | **Twigs:** bare, vertical branches | **Root system:** shallow, slightly branched
