Tree types: solitary shrubs

USE

Location: park, in containers, large garden | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide weeping | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 5 - 8 m | **Width:** 10 - 15 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5B - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, nectar value 3, pollen value 3

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: raceme, striking, half filled | **Flower colour:** pale pink | **Flowering period:** March - April | **Leaf colour:** buds bronze, green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, doubly serrate | **Autumn colour:** yellow-orange | **Fruits:** small, drupe | **Fruit colour:** black | **Bark colour:** grey-brown, black | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** brown, green | **Twigs:** bare
