TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, multi-stemmed trees, shade trees

USE

Location: park, large garden | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: vase-shaped | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 5 - 8 m | **Width:** 6 - 10 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, nectar value 3, pollen value 3

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: striking, singular, stuffed | **Flower colour:** white, pink | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** buds bronze, green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, serrate | **Autumn colour:** yellow-orange | **Fruits:** no fruit | **Bark colour:** red-brown | **Bark:** slightly furrowed | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** bare
