## TYPES OF PLANTING

**Tree types:** standard trees, multi-stemmed trees | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

## USE

**Location:** street, park, large garden | **Pavement:** none, open, sealed

## CHARACTERISTICS

**Crown shape:** ovoid | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 8 - 10 m | **Width:** 4 - 8 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 3A - 8B

## ASPECTS

**Wind:** intolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** butterflies

## PLANTKENMERKEN

**Flowers:** raceme, star-shaped, pendulous, small | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** red-violet, buds pale green | **Leaves:** deciduous, lanceolate, polished, serrate | **Autumn colour:** red-brown | **Fruits:** small, drupe | **Fruit colour:** dark red, black | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** grey-brown | **Twigs:** bare
