### TYPES OF PLANTING

**Tree types:** standard trees, multi-stemmed trees, shade trees, characteristic trees, solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** roof-trained, vase, multi-stem umbrella

### USE

**Location:** avenue, park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery | **Pavement:** none

### CHARACTERISTICS

**Crown shape:** wide vase-shaped | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 6 - 12 m | **Width:** 6 - 10 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 9B

### ASPECTS

**Wind:** intolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, birds

### PLANTKENMERKEN

**Flowers:** striking, singular, flower-scented | **Flower colour:** white, white-pink, pale pink | **Flowering period:** April - April | **Leaf colour:** buds bronze, green | **Leaves:** deciduous, obovate, ovoid, serrate | **Autumn colour:** yellow-orange, orange-red | **Fruits:** discrete, cherry, drupe | **Fruit colour:** black | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** striped | **Twig colour:** grey-brown | **Twigs:** bare, with lenticels | **Root system:** deep, highly branched, tap root, on own root
