USE

Location: avenue, park, large garden, cemetery, bioswale | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Solid planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 12 - 15 m | **Width:** 14 - 20 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist, wet | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to short-term flooding

Flowers: catkins | **Flower colour:** green | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, big, pinnate | **Autumn colour:** yellow | **Fruits:** striking, winged, large, catkins | **Fruit colour:** brown-green | **Bark colour:** brown, grey | **Bark:** furrowed | **Twig colour:** brown-green | **Twigs:** bare
