TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, multi-stemmed trees, shade trees, characteristic trees, solitary shrubs

USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** urban planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: flattened spherical | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 6 - 8 m | **Width:** 6 - 8 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 9A

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, nectar value 1, pollen value 1 | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness

Flowers: raceme, panicle, bell-shaped, striking, pendulous, flower-scented | **Flower colour:** cream-white | **Flowering period:** June - July | **Leaf colour:** pale green, underside grey-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovoid, underside hairy | **Autumn colour:** yellow, yellow-green | **Fruits:** hairy, rough, drupe | **Fruit colour:** brown, green | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** furrowed, aromatic | **Twig colour:** dark brown | **Twigs:** bare, finely branched | **Root system:** shallow, extensive
