USE

Location: street, avenue, square, park, central reservation, in containers, roof garden, large garden, traffic areas, industrial zones | **Pavement:** none, open, sealed | **Planting concepts:** Prairie planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: egg-shaped | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 8 - 15 m | **Width:** 6 - 9 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 9A

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind, tolerant to wind | **Soil:** sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** low in nutrients, moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** very dry, dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, nectar value 3, pollen value 3 | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution
