TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, multi-stemmed trees, climate trees, solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** beehive, block, cylinder, pyramid, cone, roof-trained, multi-stem umbrella, espalier, pleached | **Topiary:** cylinder, column, archway, espalier

USE

Location: street, avenue, square, car park / parking lot, park, central reservation, in containers, roof garden, large garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, coastal area | **Pavement:** none, open, sealed | **Planting concepts:** Climate planting, Eco planting, Prairie planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: pyramidal | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 8 - 12 m | **Width:** 4 - 6 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5B - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** low in nutrients, moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline (5.5 - 8.0) | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, birds, nectar value 3, pollen value 3 | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution, tolerates heat

Flowers: raceme, singular, small | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, polished | **Autumn colour:** red-violet | **Fruits:** rarely fruits, small, drupe | **Fruit colour:** brown | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** smooth, later on rough | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** bare | **Root system:** deep, extensive
