



TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, half-stem trees, characteristic trees, fruit trees, woodland planting stock | **Topiary on stem**: multi-stem umbrella | **Topiary**: espalier

USE

Location: avenue, park, central reservation, roof garden, large garden, traffic areas, industrial zones, countryside, ecological zone, coastal area | **Pavement**: none, open, sealed | **Planting concepts**: food forest

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: egg-shaped | Crown structure: semi-open | Height: 10 - 15 m | Width: 5 - 10 m | Winter hardiness zone: 5A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | Soil: loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | Nutrient level: moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | Soil moisture level: moist | Light requirements: sun, partial shade | pH range: neutral, alkaline | Host plant/forage plant: bees, butterflies, birds, small mammals, humans, nectar value 5, pollen value 5 | Extreme environments: tolerates air pollution

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: raceme, striking, standing, flower-scented | Flower colour: white | Flowering period: April - May | Leaf colour: green, underside pale green | Leaves: deciduous, ovate, leathery, polished, serrate | Autumn colour: yellow-orange | Fruits: striking, edible, aromatic, pear | Fruit colour: yellow-green | Bark colour: grey-brown | Bark: furrowed | Twig colour: grey-brown | Twigs: thorned
