Tree types: solitary shrubs | **Other types of planting:** undergrowth, ground cover, climbing plants

USE

Location: park, in containers, roof garden, small garden, coastal area | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Climate planting, Prairie planting, shade-tolerant, Eco planting, Solid planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Height: 0.5 - 1.5 m | **Width:** 0.8 - 1.5 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil, all soils | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline (5.5 - 7.5) | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, nectar value 5, pollen value 5 | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to salt spray, tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution, tolerates heat

Flowers: umbels, striking | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** May - June | **Leaf colour:** green, dark green | **Leaves:** evergreen, polished | **Autumn colour:** yellow-orange, orange-red | **Fruits:** striking | **Fruit colour:** orange, red | **Bark colour:** dark brown, grey-black | **Bark:** slightly furrowed | **Twig colour:** pale brown | **Twigs:** thorned | **Root system:** extensive, highly branched
