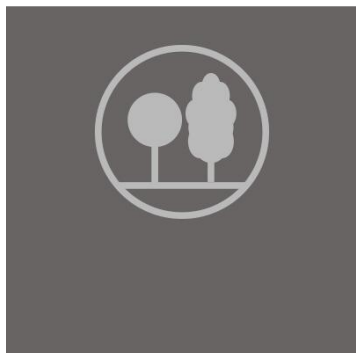


Pyrus communis 'Williams Christbirne'

TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, half-stem trees, fruit trees

USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden, small garden, patio, coastal area | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** food forest, Eco planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide pyramidal | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 3 - 5 m | **Width:** 2 - 4 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind, slightly tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** sabulous clay, heavy clay, light clay, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, birds, small mammals, humans, nectar value 5, pollen value 5

Flowers: raceme, striking, standing | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** green, underside grey-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, ovoid, leathery, polished, serrate | **Autumn colour:** yellow-orange | **Fruits:** striking, edible, large, aromatic, pear | **Fruit colour:** golden yellow | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** furrowed | **Twig colour:** brown | **Twigs:** bare
