Location: park, central reservation, in containers, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, coastal area | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Climate planting, Prairie planting, shade-tolerant, Eco planting, Solid planting

Height: 1.5 - 2 m | **Width:** 1.5 - 2 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, slightly tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil, all soils | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral (6.1 - 7.5) | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to salt spray, tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution, tolerates heat

Flowers: umbels, striking | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** June - July | **Leaf colour:** green, dark green | **Leaves:** evergreen, lanceolate, narrow, smooth | **Fruits:** striking | **Fruit colour:** red | **Bark colour:** brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** brown, red | **Twigs:** thorned | **Root system:** extensive, highly branched, coarse roots
