Tree types: standard trees

USE

Location: street, square, park, large garden, coastal area | **Pavement:** none, open, sealed

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 6 - 10 m | **Width:** 5 - 7 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** sabulous clay, heavy clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** low in nutrients, moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to salt spray

Flowers: corymbose, striking, standing | **Flower colour:** cream-white | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** felty white, green, silver | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovoid, hairy, dentate | **Autumn colour:** dark red | **Fruits:** discrete, small, pear | **Fruit colour:** yellow, green | **Bark colour:** grey-black | **Bark:** deeply furrowed | **Twig colour:** grey-brown | **Twigs:** hairy
