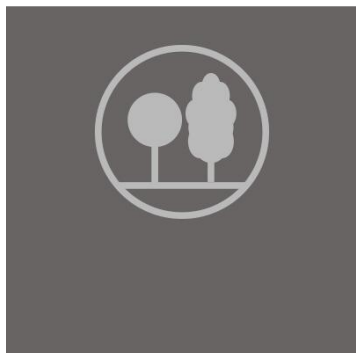


Pyrus salicifolia

TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, characteristic trees, solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: street, square, park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, coastal area | **Pavement:** none, open, sealed

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 6 - 8 m | **Width:** 5 - 7 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, nectar value 3, pollen value 3 | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: corymbose, discrete, singular | **Flower colour:** cream-white | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** green, grey felty | **Leaves:** deciduous, lanceolate, narrow, hairy | **Autumn colour:** green, grey | **Fruits:** rarely fruits, large, pear | **Fruit colour:** green | **Bark colour:** grey-black | **Bark:** furrowed | **Twig colour:** grey | **Twigs:** thorned, hairy
