### TYPES OF PLANTING

**Tree types:** standard trees, multi-stemmed trees, shade trees | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

### USE

**Location:** avenue, square, park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones | **Pavement:** none, open, sealed | **Planting concepts:** urban planting

### CHARACTERISTICS

**Crown shape:** wide oval | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 15 - 20 m | **Width:** 12 - 15 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 9B

### ASPECTS

**Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to salt spray, tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution

**Flowers:** catkins, discrete | **Flower colour:** yellow | **Flowering period:** April - April | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovoid, lacinate, lobate | **Autumn colour:** red | **Fruits:** small, acorn | **Fruit colour:** brown | **Bark colour:** grey-black | **Bark:** furrowed | **Twig colour:** yellow, brown
