



TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: shade trees, characteristic trees, solitary shrubs

USE

Location: avenue, square, park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, countryside | **Pavement**: none, open, sealed | **Planting concepts**: Eco planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: flattened spherical | Crown structure: semi-open | Height: 15 - 20 m | Width: 15 - 20 m | Winter hardiness zone: 7A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, slightly tolerant to coastal wind | Soil: loess, sabulous clay, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | Nutrient level: moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | Soil moisture level: moist | Light requirements: sun, partial shade | pH range: acidic, neutral | Host plant/forage plant: bees, butterflies, birds, small mammals | Extreme environments: tolerant to salt spray, tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: catkins, striking, pendulous | Flower colour: golden yellow | Flowering period: May - June | Leaf colour: green, underside greygreen | Leaves: semi-evergreen, ovoid, leathery, matt polished, underside hairy, dentate, lobate | Autumn colour: brown, green | Fruits: acorn | Fruit colour: brown | Bark colour: grey | Bark: furrowed | Twig colour: grey-brown | Twigs: hairy, bare | Root system: deep, extensive
