Tree types: solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem**: multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: park, large garden, traffic areas, industrial zones | Pavement: none | Planting concepts: Prairie planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | Crown structure: dense | Height: 15 - 20 m | Width: 6 - 10 m | Winter hardiness zone: 7A - 10B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | Soil: sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | Nutrient level: moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | Soil moisture level: dry | Light requirements: sun | pH range: neutral, alkaline | Extreme environments: tolerant to salt spray, tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: catkins, discrete, pendulous | Flower colour: golden yellow | Flowering period: May - June | Leaf colour: grey-green, grey felty | Leaves: deciduous, obovate, big, leathery, underside hairy, lobate | Autumn colour: yellow-brown | Fruits: acorn | Fruit colour: brown-green | Bark colour: grey-brown | Bark: peeling, deeply furrowed | Twig colour: orange, brown, green | Twigs: hairy
