**Location:** street, park, large garden, traffic areas, industrial zones | **Pavement:** none

### CHARACTERISTICS

**Crown shape:** narrow pyramidal | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 20 - 25 m | **Width:** 5 - 7 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 8B

### ASPECTS

**Wind:** tolerant to wind | **Soil:** sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist, wet | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to salt spray, tolerates air pollution

**Flowers:** catkins, discrete | **Flower colour:** golden yellow | **Flowering period:** May - May | **Leaf colour:** buds red, green, underside grey-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, obovate, polished, lacinate, dentate, lobate | **Autumn colour:** scarlet | **Fruits:** striking, small, acorn | **Fruit colour:** red-brown | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** bare
