TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, multi-stemmed trees, solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: park, large garden, small garden, traffic areas, industrial zones | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 4 - 6 m | **Width:** 4 - 5 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to salt spray, tolerates air pollution

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: catkins, striking, pendulous, big | **Flower colour:** golden yellow, yellow, red | **Flowering period:** May - May | **Leaf colour:** green, underside blue-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, obovate, ovoid, leathery, dentate | **Autumn colour:** yellow-brown | **Fruits:** acorn | **Fruit colour:** brown-green | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** peeling, furrowed | **Twig colour:** yellow, green | **Twigs:** bare
