USE

Location: park, large garden, traffic areas, industrial zones, countryside | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Landscape planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: egg-shaped | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 10 - 15 m | **Width:** 5 - 10 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6B - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist, wet | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** butterflies | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to salt spray, tolerates air pollution

Flowers: catkins, discrete, pendulous | **Flower colour:** yellow-brown | **Flowering period:** June - June | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** ovate, matt polished, slightly hairy, lobate | **Autumn colour:** brown | **Fruits:** acorn | **Fruit colour:** brown | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** furrowed | **Twig colour:** grey-brown
