### TYPES OF PLANTING

**Tree types:** standard trees, feathered trees, multi-stemmed trees, shade trees, characteristic trees, solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

### USE

**Location:** street, square, park, central reservation, roof garden, large garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones | **Pavement:** open, sealed

### CHARACTERISTICS

**Crown shape:** wide pyramidal | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 6 - 10 m | **Width:** 6 - 10 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 9B

### ASPECTS

**Wind:** slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** neutral, alkaline | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to salt spray, tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution

### PLANTKENMERKEN

**Flowers:** catkins, striking, pendulous | **Flower colour:** silver | **Flowering period:** May - May | **Leaf colour:** dark green, underside felty white | **Leaves:** evergreen, ovoid, leathery, matt polished, dentate, lobate | **Fruits:** discrete, acorn | **Fruit colour:** brown | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** furrowed | **Twig colour:** yellow | **Twigs:** hairy
