USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 15 - 18 m | **Width:** 15 - 18 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 7A - 11A

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution

Flowers: catkins, pendulous | **Flower colour:** grey | **Flowering period:** May - May | **Leaf colour:** dark green, underside grey-green | **Leaves:** semi-evergreen, ovoid, leathery, dentate, lobate | **Autumn colour:** yellow-brown | **Fruits:** discrete, acorn | **Fruit colour:** brown | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** furrowed | **Twig colour:** pale brown | **Twigs:** hairy
