Tree types: woodland planting stock, solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden, small garden

CHARACTERISTICS

Height: 3 - 5 m | **Width:** 3 - 5 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** peaty, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees

Flowers: raceme, infundibular, striking | **Flower colour:** pale violet | **Flowering period:** May - May | **Leaf colour:** dark green | **Leaves:** evergreen, lanceolate, leathery, polished, undulate | **Fruits:** striking, capsule | **Fruit colour:** brown | **Bark colour:** brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** bare
