USE

Location: park, central reservation, in containers, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery, countryside, ecological zone, windbreak, coastal area | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Eco planting, Landscape planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Height: 0.5 - 2 m | **Width:** 2 - 4 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5B - 7B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral (4.6 - 7.8) | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, small mammals, birds | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution

Flowers: raceme, rosette-shaped, rose scent | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** June - July | **Leaf colour:** blue-green | **Leaves:** ovate, lanceolate, leaf thorns, serrate | **Autumn colour:** yellow-brown | **Fruits:** hips | **Fruit colour:** orange, red | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** furrowed | **Twig colour:** green | **Twigs:** bare, polished | **Root system:** deep, extensive, coarse roots, fleshy roots, central root
