Flowers: corymbose, rosette-shaped, striking, stuffed, weakly scented | **Flower colour:** pink | **Flowering period:** July - September | **Leaf colour:** dark green | **Leaves:** obovate, ovoid | **Autumn colour:** yellow-brown | **Fruits:** rarely fruits, hips | **Fruit colour:** red | **Bark colour:** cream, grey-brown | **Bark:** slightly furrowed | **Twig colour:** red, green | **Twigs:** thorned | **Root system:** deep, extensive
