Tree types: solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: park, large garden, small garden, cemetery | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Eco planting, urban planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide egg-shaped | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 1 - 3 m | **Width:** 1 - 2 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | **Soil:** sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** low in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, nectar value 4, pollen value 4 | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness

Flowers: raceme, papilionaceous, striking, pendulous | **Flower colour:** dark pink | **Flowering period:** May - June | **Leaf colour:** green, underside grey | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovoid, leaf thorns, pinnate, Nitrogen fixing | **Autumn colour:** yellow | **Fruits:** striking, thorned, pod | **Fruit colour:** violet | **Bark colour:** brown | **Bark:** furrowed | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** thorned | **Root system:** shallow, extensive,
