TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, half-stem trees, climate trees | **Topiary on stem:** globe

USE

Location: street, car park / parking lot, park, small garden, patio, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones | **Pavement:** none, open | **Planting concepts:** Climate planting, Solid planting, Prairie planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 4 - 6 m | **Width:** 3 - 7 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to salt spray, tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution, tolerates heat

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowering period: non-flowering | **Leaf colour:** blue-green, buds bright green | **Leaves:** deciduous, pinnate, Nitrogen fixing | **Autumn colour:** yellow | **Fruits:** no fruit | **Bark colour:** pale brown | **Bark:** deeply furrowed, thornless | **Twig colour:** brown | **Twigs:** (almost) thornless | **Root system:** shallow, tap root, clinging aerial roots
