Location: street, avenue, square, park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones | **Pavement:** none, open, sealed | **Planting concepts:** Climate planting, Eco planting, Landscape planting, Solid planting, Prairie planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide pyramidal | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 15 - 20 m | **Width:** 8 - 10 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** low in nutrients, moderately rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** very dry, dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, nectar value 5, pollen value 5 | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to salt spray, tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution, tolerates heat

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: raceme, papilionaceous, striking, pendulous, big, scented | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** June - June | **Leaf colour:** dark green, underside grey-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovoid, matt polished, pinnate, composite, ternate, Nitrogen fixing | **Autumn colour:** yellow | **Fruits:** rarely fruits, pod | **Fruit colour:** red-brown | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** deeply furrowed | **Twig colour:** brown | **Twigs:** bare, vertical branches | **Root system:** shallow, tap root, clinging aerial roots
