Location: street, avenue, park, central reservation, large garden, traffic areas, industrial zones, countryside, ecological zone, bioswale | **Pavement:** none, open, sealed | **Planting concepts:** Eco planting, Landscape planting

Crown shape: egg-shaped | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 15 - 25 m | **Width:** 12 - 18 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** peaty, heavy clay, sand | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist, wet, very wet | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, nectar value 5, pollen value 5 | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution, tolerant to short-term flooding
