USE

Location: street, park, traffic areas, industrial zones, countryside, ecological zone, bioswale | **Pavement:** none, open, sealed | **Planting concepts:** Prairie planting, Eco planting, Landscape planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: pyramidal | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 20 - 25 m | **Width:** 15 - 20 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** all soils | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist, wet, very wet | **Light requirements:** sun | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, nectar value 5, pollen value 5 | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution, tolerant to short-term flooding

Flowers: catkins | **Flower colour:** yellow, green | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** felty white, grey-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, lanceolate, narrow, hairy | **Autumn colour:** yellow | **Fruits:** discrete, catkins | **Fruit colour:** brown | **Bark colour:** grey | **Bark:** furrowed | **Twig colour:** red-brown
